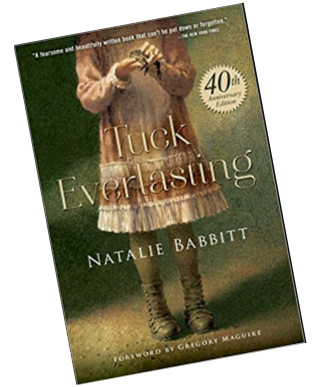


Summer Book Project for 6th Grade Language Arts

After reading the book *Tuck Everlasting*, please complete the following activities.

PART 1: Tuck Everlasting Story Map

Directions: Draw a map on 11 x 17 white paper of the following key places in the story. Write (on a separate sheet of paper) a paragraph for each place explaining why it was important in the story and attach it to your map:

1. Foster's House
2. The Spring
3. The Pond
4. Tuck's House
5. Jailhouse
6. Cemetery

Important:

- Please make sure to label each place and color your map. Don't forget to draw in a trail linking each place as it takes place in the book. You may want to include characters in some of your places but it is not necessary.
- Write a complete paragraph (must be at least five sentences), and make sure to check for proper spelling, punctuation and grammar.

PART II: Compare/Contrast the movie and the book

Directions: Watch the movie *Tuck Everlasting* (if you are an Amazon Prime member you can get it for free). Use a Venn Diagram to compare/contrast major plot points between the movie and the book. Then write a paragraph explaining the similarities and difference on the back of the Venn Diagram. Make sure to write **four** things to compare and contrast and **three** things that were the same.
